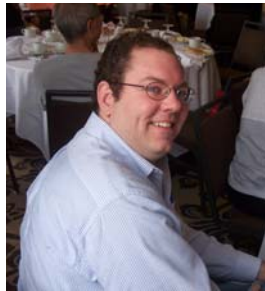

CUT BACK ON SALT

- ◆ Put the salt shaker down
- ◆ Step away from processed foods
 - ◆ Read labels for sodium content
 - ◆ Limit intake of convenience food
 - ◆ Avoid salt during cooking
 - ◆ Fill the shaker with herbs & spices
 - ◆ Try sea or kosher salt - larger crystals

ADD POTASSIUM - focus on fruits & vegetables

- ◆ Cantaloupe
 - ◆ Oranges
 - ◆ tangerines
 - ◆ Dark green leafy
 - ◆ Tomatoes
 - ◆ Winter squash
 - ◆ Spinach
 - ◆ potatoes
- Other good sources:
- ◆ Almonds
 - ◆ Non-fat dairy products

Links to BLOOD PRESSURE

- ◆ Older adults are salt sensitive
- ◆ Potassium is the 'anti-salt' & may reduce blood pressure

If you have kidney problems, heart disease or high blood pressure, please consult your doctor before increasing potassium. Limit salt intake to under 2300 mg daily.

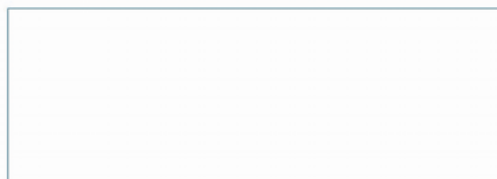
